

## CTC Cymru Touring Rides - 1

### **CORWEN to BALA CYCLE RIDE**

#### **Description**

A scenic but reasonably easy 25 mile ride along the Upper Dee Valley using mainly quiet lanes or B roads. The ride can be started either at Bala from the Lake Car Park or Corwen. [Green Lane Car Park].

From Corwen.

1. Turn Left out of Green Lane Public Car Park & Turn Right onto A5.

2. Turn Left by HSBC Bank & climb [this is quite steep] Excellent views from the top.

3. Turn Left onto the B4401 & follow to the village of Cynwyd, Turn Right opposite the Blue Lion Pub & cross River Dee [Afon Dyfrdwy].

4. Turn Left immediately after crossing the river & follow the lane to the village of Llandderfel.

5. Turn Left at T junction in Llandderfel & follow to War Memorial, where turn Right onto B4402 & continue to T junction with A494, Turn Left & follow to Bala.

6. On entering Bala continue into town to cafes & shops, & continue through town to Llyn Tegid. Public toilets, café & excellent views across the lake to the Aran mountain range.

7. Turn Left at lake either into car park & cycle along foreshore or walk along the footpath, **[If starting from Bala route starts here]** Turn Right at end onto B4391.

8. Continue on B4391 then fork Left Sign Posted Llandderfel B4402.

9. Turn Right onto B4401 Sign Posted Corwen & follow to Corwen where Turn Right onto A5 & follow into town & Turn Left to car park & of end of ride. **If Starting from Bala** follow from instruction 7.
